

2024 Directors' Fees Report

The *2024 Directors' Fees Report*, produced by The Institute of Directors (IoD) and EY, is a key source of information on directors' remuneration in the New Zealand market. It also provides useful insights into the evolving expectations on directors across a range of industries. Below are a selection of key statistics and important trends drawn from the survey of 4,077 directorships, held by 1,148 directors, across 1,752 organisations.

(Median hours of work per annum for non-executive directors)



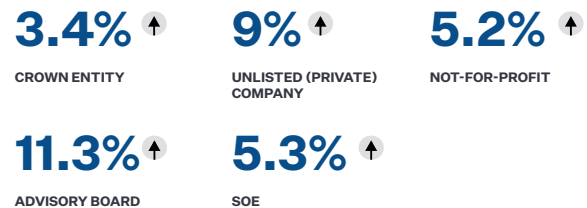

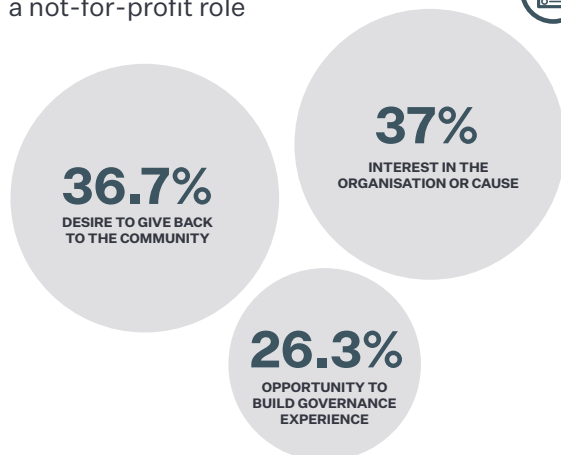

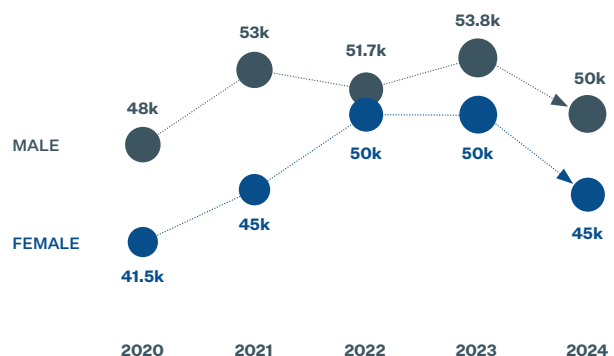
Fee movement by entity type
